16 Hour Classes:

Hazardous Materials: Technician Level Practicum

PREREQUISITE: Current **HAZMAT OPERATIONS LEVEL CERTIFICATION**

This competency-based course is designed to promote the Operations Level hazmat responder to Technician Level certification in compliance with 29 CFR 1910.120 (q), (6), (iii) and includes scenario based activities in Hazmat scene management, hazard control, & incident mitigation.

Rope Rescue Confine Space:

Covers Rescue Equipment, Ropes, Knots, Repelling, Raises & Lowers
Haul Systems, Confined Space Entry & Rescue, Supplied Breathing Air Systems

Rope Rescue High Angle:

Covers Rescue Equipment, Ropes, Knots, Telfer Lines, Anchors & Anchor Point, Knot Passing, Patient Transfer

Rookie Class:

This course is designed for new fire fighters. It contains, SCBA, Protective Clothing, Hose Handling, Fire Stream Practices & Fire Extinguishment.

Basic Vehicle Extrication:

Introduction to hydraulic tools, cribbing and air bags. This course will focus on basic extrication techniques, patient packaging and patient removal

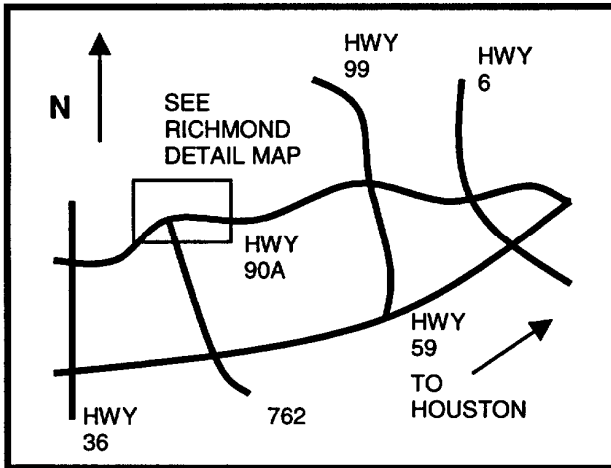
Intermediate Vehicle Extrication:

Realistic scenarios with live patients. This course will focus on specialized extrication scenarios

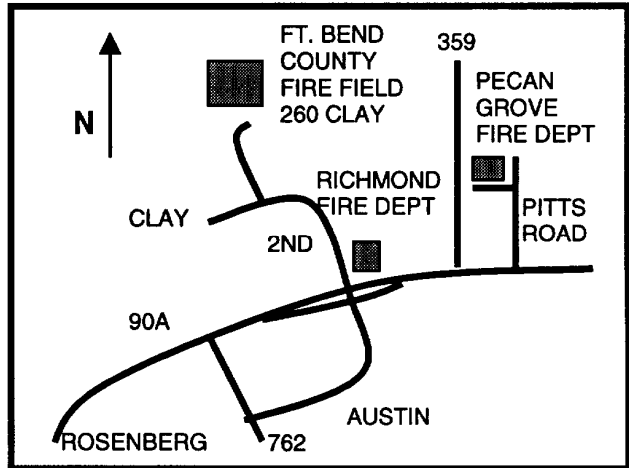
