Division offers public works, transportation, utilities and applied technology training for a highly diversified group of areas, and reaches and serves most skill groups and departments found in government, and also tailors training specifically for the needs of industrial and private sector customers. Core training includes building codes, heavy equipment operator, environmental, water and wastewater, homeland security, transportation and occupational safety, city/county assistance, Texas Local Technical Assistance Program, telecommunications and electric power. Training and technical assistance at the Frank M. Tejeda Center enhances the effectiveness, efficiency and sustainability

of water/wastewater utility operations along the Texas/Mexico border. The Public Works Response Team supports local jurisdictions in their response to a catastrophic event by providing public works technical assistance as needed to facilitate re-entry and recovery of essential services and critical infrastructure.
