## G362 – MULTI-HAZARDS EMERGENCY PLANNING FOR SCHOOLS

**When & Where:** April 13-14, 2010 Uvalde, Tx

**Course Length:** Sixteen Hours (16)

## **G-235, EMERGENCY PLANNING**

**When:** March 3-5, 2010

**Where:** Austin, Texas

**Course:** G-235, Emergency Planning

## Hazard Mitigation Planning Course (G710)

**When & Where:** March 9-11, 2010 Orange County, Tx

**Cost:** There is no cost to attend TDEM sponsored courses (see DEM Training Calendar for Travel Reimbursement)

**Course Length:** Sixteen (16) Hours
