

EmCom Training – EMROG Digital Net Procedure

Digital Net Procedure

- Digital check-in by sending a packet (Airmail or equivalent) message to WB5EXI via Radio - VHF RMS Server (Or Pactor/Winmor HF Station) - Winlink System; Internet (or Telnet) does not count. The purpose of this net is to check out your radio and TNC equipment and to practice with Airmail or equivalent.
- Time period to check-in: Anytime between Friday and Monday at 7:00PM on
- Please list the RMS Server used and the date/time the message written in Subject Line
- Will try to list digital check-ins during RACES/EMROG Net
- Monday evening or Tuesday I will send out a list of all the check-ins to all that checked-in.

Local Fort Bend County RMS Server Stations

- 145.050 MHz provides a number of RMS Server sites; The following are the stations that can usually be connected to from Sugar Land:
 - KD5HAL-10 (Richmond); it does have Digipeat ON as KD5HAL-5
 - WD8RZA-10 (Katy); I believe that it has Digipeat ON as WD8RZA-5
 - KD5WHD-10 (Red Cross) sometimes active; and sometimes I go through the ALVIN digipeater;
Connect to: KD5WHD-10 ALVIN
 - N5DCC-10 (Pasadena); sometimes I go through the ALVIN digipeater;
Connect to: N5DCC-10 ALVIN
 - WB5EXI-10 (Sugar Land) is usually on Thursday or Friday evening through Sunday Evening.
 - KD5YOU-10 (Pecan Ridge near Richmond) is on Monday Evening.
- There is a digipeater on 145.090 that may let you connect to NW Houston/Harris Co.
 - KK5W (Sharpstown); Cross over digi for SW Houston to KB5HCD-10
